The Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) regulations require all PAC settings to assess and document specific quality measures for each patient. Attendees will learn strategies to address these quality indicators and implement evidence-based strategies to improve patient outcomes. This interactive course.

Evidence-based nursing interventions for each of the following quality indicators will be addressed: Cognitive Patterns, Functional Abilities, Skin Conditions, Falls, and Bowel & Bladder Continence.
